ILLUSTRATIVE RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

- Organizing practices and season events
- Monitoring the academic progress of student athletes throughout the season
- Include issuing and collecting uniforms
- **Collection of Athletic Registration Fees**
- Providing an orientation of a sound training and expectations to all student athlete participants
- Developing fundamental skills, coach ability, team concept, understanding roles
- Communicating with the Varsity Coach and Athletic Director on the progression of the student athletes in the program.
