

TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Our top priority at Montrose Community Schools is to provide a safe learning environment for our children. The learning environment begins when the children get on the bus in the morning and extends to the time when they get off the bus in the afternoon. This year we will again provide each family with one address where their student(s) can be picked up in the morning and one address where their student(s) will be dropped off in the afternoon. We base our bus routes on picking up and dropping off your child at your home address. If your "transportation address" will be some place other than your home, please fill out the form below and return it to the Administration building. **ALL NEW STUDENTS WHO ENROLL THROUGHOUT THE YEAR WILL NEED TO COMPLETE THIS FORM WITH THEIR HOME ADDRESS (this is how they will be added to the bus routes).** As always, we will work with individual families to assist with special situations. Please call or stop in to speak with me if you feel your situation falls into this category.

In an effort to provide an efficient busing system, we will continue with our "no bus pass" system. With having a consistent "transportation address" for all children, this eliminates the need for bus passes. If an emergency arises and you need your child to be dropped off at a different address, please give me a call and we will work with you. If you have any other questions or concerns, please feel free to contact me at any time. Thank you for working with our transportation staff to make this another safe year for our students.

For our Elementary students, we ask that our drivers make visual contact with another person before leaving your child at their stop. We understand that each individual situation is different, but please take the time to make sure your child's bus driver knows who will be there to pick up your child at the bus stop. If you are comfortable with your child going home without visual contact, we will allow them to get off the bus without a parent/guardian present. To do this, you must have a written note on file with the school. If there is not a parent/guardian at the stop, the child will be brought back to Carter Elementary to be picked up. A new form will need to be filled out each year so we have a current note on file. We thank you for your efforts to keep all of our children safe.
