Dear Parents and Guardians:

Today all students were given a letter discussing the procedures used to help stop the spread of COVID-19. This letter is a follow up letter explaining additional protocols that will be implemented immediately and remain in effect until April 6, 2020.

- All community meetings, rentals, and gatherings scheduled to take place within MCS school facilities are canceled. This includes scheduled PTO events or meetings and all facility rentals.
- All assemblies and performances involving participation by the general public are canceled.
- All post season banquets and award ceremonies are canceled.
- All field trips are suspended until further notice.
- All student awards or incentive programs for "perfect attendance" are temporarily suspended, effective immediately. Please do not send sick children to school.
- Any after-school activity that meets on our campus in a small group and is an extension of the normal learning day (clubs, athletic practices, etc.) will continue as planned.

We understand this is an anxious time for families. At this point in time, the Genesee County Health Department is not recommending the closure of schools in Genesee County. However, we realize that this situation is rapidly evolving and that there may be individual cases that require different decisions to be made in other school districts. Regardless of future decisions that may need to be made, we want our community to know that we are treating this unprecedented situation with the highest degree of concern one day at a time.
