Tonight, approximately 30 minutes after the commencement ceremony, it was reported that an individual, not affiliated with Montrose Community Schools, was in possession of a weapon. In an abundance of caution, the onsite police officers called for additional backup to investigate the claim. Within a few moments, onsite administration identified the individual. The individual was detained, questioned, and searched by law enforcement. In addition, law enforcement and district administration canvassed the district property and surrounding areas. Recorded and live security camera footage was used to track the accused individual's whereabouts. No evidence of a weapon was found onsite.

The ongoing investigation is being handled by local law enforcement. We would like to thank the Montrose Township Police, Michigan State Police Department, and the Genesee County Sheriff's Department for their swift reaction to the situation.
