## **Return To Remote Learning**

As a result of Governor Whitmer's announcement that the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) has issued an epidemic order placing all Michigan High Schools back into remote learning on Wednesday, November 18, 2020, HMHS will not be holding in-person instruction from November 18 - December 8, 2020.

## **Schedule**

Sunday evening, Governor Whitmer communicated that the MDHHS was issuing an epidemic order returning all Michigan high schools to remote learning on Wednesday November 18, 2020. Hill-McCloy High School will be transitioning into the Remote Learning Environment (RLE) beginning on **Wednesday, November 18, 2020**. Our RLE will be in effect until at least Tuesday, **December 8, 2020**. Below you will find information regarding the impact to both Montrose Virtual School and Face to Face student expectations and schedules:

- **ALL FACE TO FACE STUDENTS SHOULD TAKE THEIR SCHOOL MATERIALS AND PERSONAL BELONGINGS HOME WITH THEM AT THE END OF THE DAY TODAY. ACCESS TO THE HIGH SCHOOL IS NOT AVAILABLE AFTER TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 2020 UNLESS YOU CALL THE MAIN OFFICE.**
- The return to remote learning will not impact students enrolled in the Montrose Virtual School (MVS). The students that have been taking their classes 100% online will continue to access their Edgenuity classes, and complete class requirements. Additional information for returning, and new MVS students is provided below.
- The return to remote learning **will impact face to face students**. These students will be expected to follow the RLE schedule and expectations identified on the attached schedule:
  - Face to Face students will transition to RLE **Wednesday, November 18, 2020**:
  - Instructor Office hours may be used to schedule Zoom or Google Meets, and/or communication with teachers and students.

*Students will continue to have access to instructors' canvas pages for daily course updates.*

## **Montrose Virtual School (100% Edgenuity)**

The return to remote learning will not impact students currently enrolled in the Montrose Virtual School (MVS) for the remainder of the first semester. The students that have been taking their classes 100% online will continue to access their Edgenuity classes to complete class requirements.

**Students taking Edgenuity classes are still responsible for all assignments, as well as participating in two-way interactions with their teachers.**

**Students should continue to follow the due dates established in their Edgenuity classes. The schedule identified below, provides additional guidance as to where student's progress should be throughout the remainder of the semester:**

- 9/8/2020 (First Day of School) 0%
- 10/7/2020 (¼ through the semester) 25%
- 11/6/2020 (½ through the semester) 50%
- 11/24/2020 (Thanksgiving Break) 66%
- 12/4/2020 (¾ through the semester) 75%
- 12/22/2020 (Christmas Break) 92%
- 1/15/2021 (End of Semester) 100%

### **Genesee Career Institute (GCI)**

Students enrolled in the [Genesee Career Institute](#) should follow the protocols established by the GCI, as well as their GCI instructor for the duration of remote learning.

Any updated information regarding the GCI will be communicated as it is received.

### **Dual Enrollment & Early Middle College Students**

Those students that are currently dual enrolled should continue to follow the protocols established by their post-secondary institution.

### **Athletics**

As part of the press conference Sunday evening, Director, Robert Gordon communicated that the MDHHS was including high school athletics in the epidemic order. As a result, all **current Fall and Winter sports practices and competitions have been postponed until December 8, 2020.**


**Any additional information regarding high school athletics will be communicated as it is received through the MDHHS and/or the MHSAA.**

Although I understand and emphasize that the current pandemic has, and may continue to create a great deal of anxiety for many students and parents, we still must have established protocols and expectations for students. It is our expectation that students will attend on line instructional Zoom Sessions and continue two-way communications with their instructors. I wish you all the best during this time of uncertainty.
